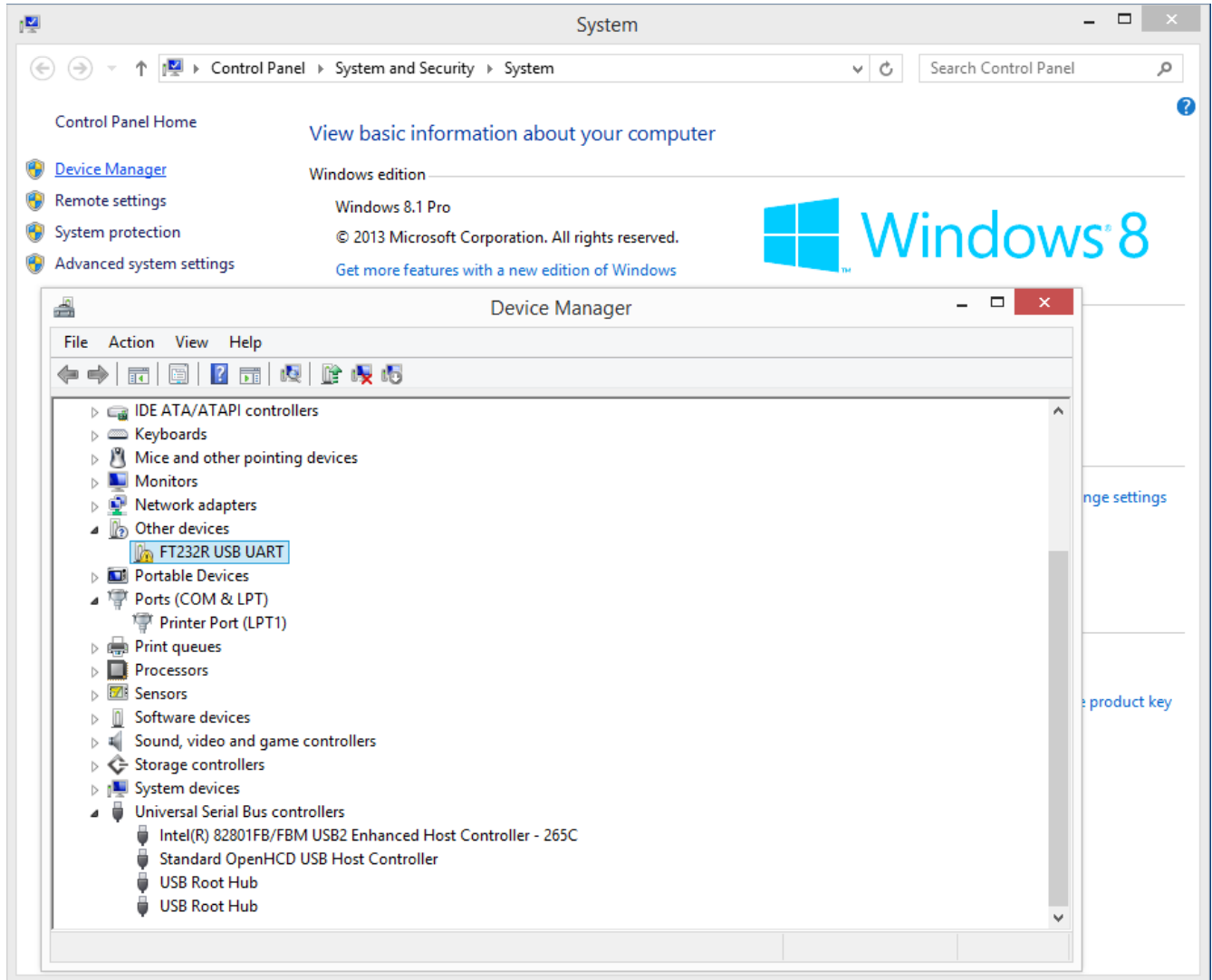
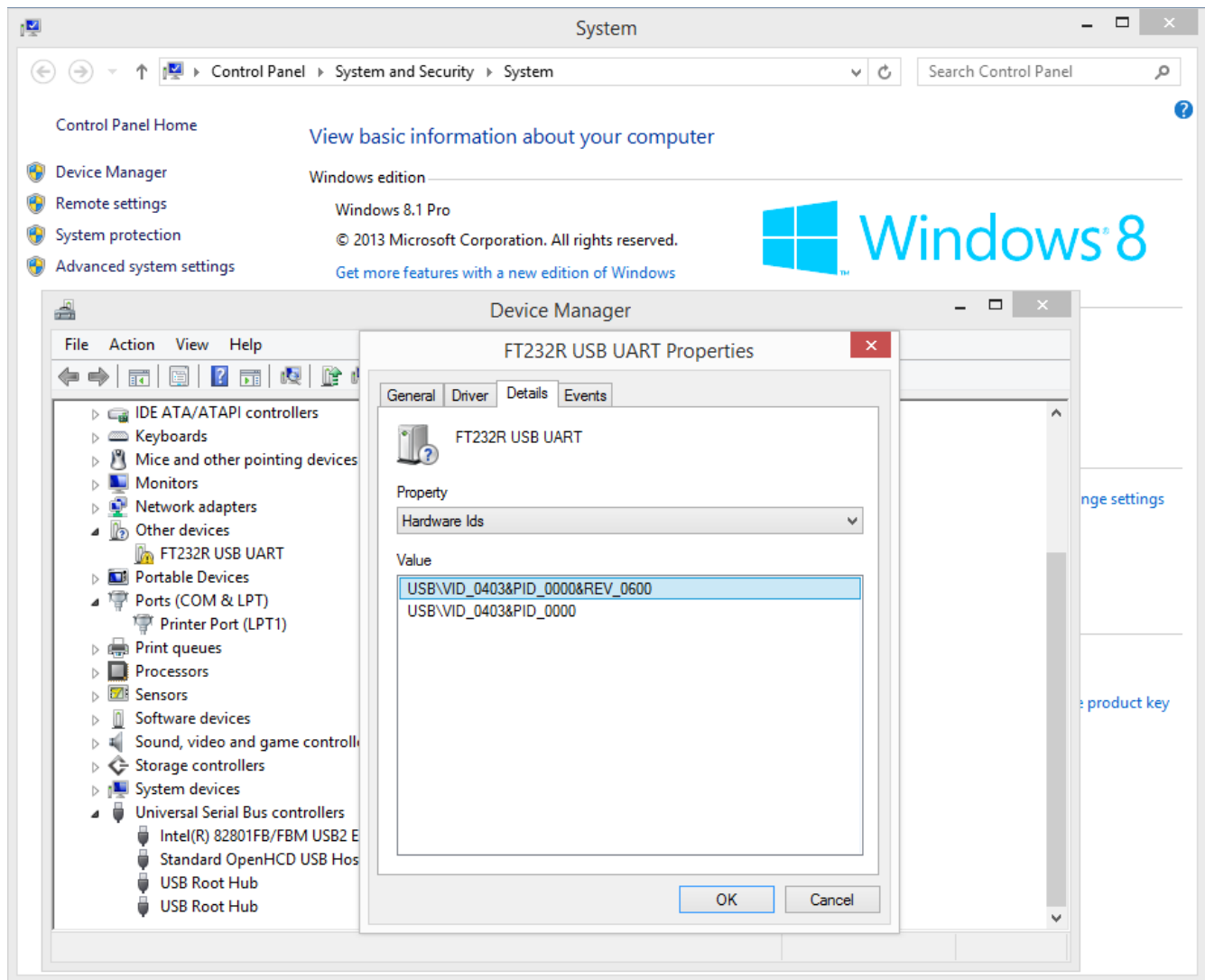


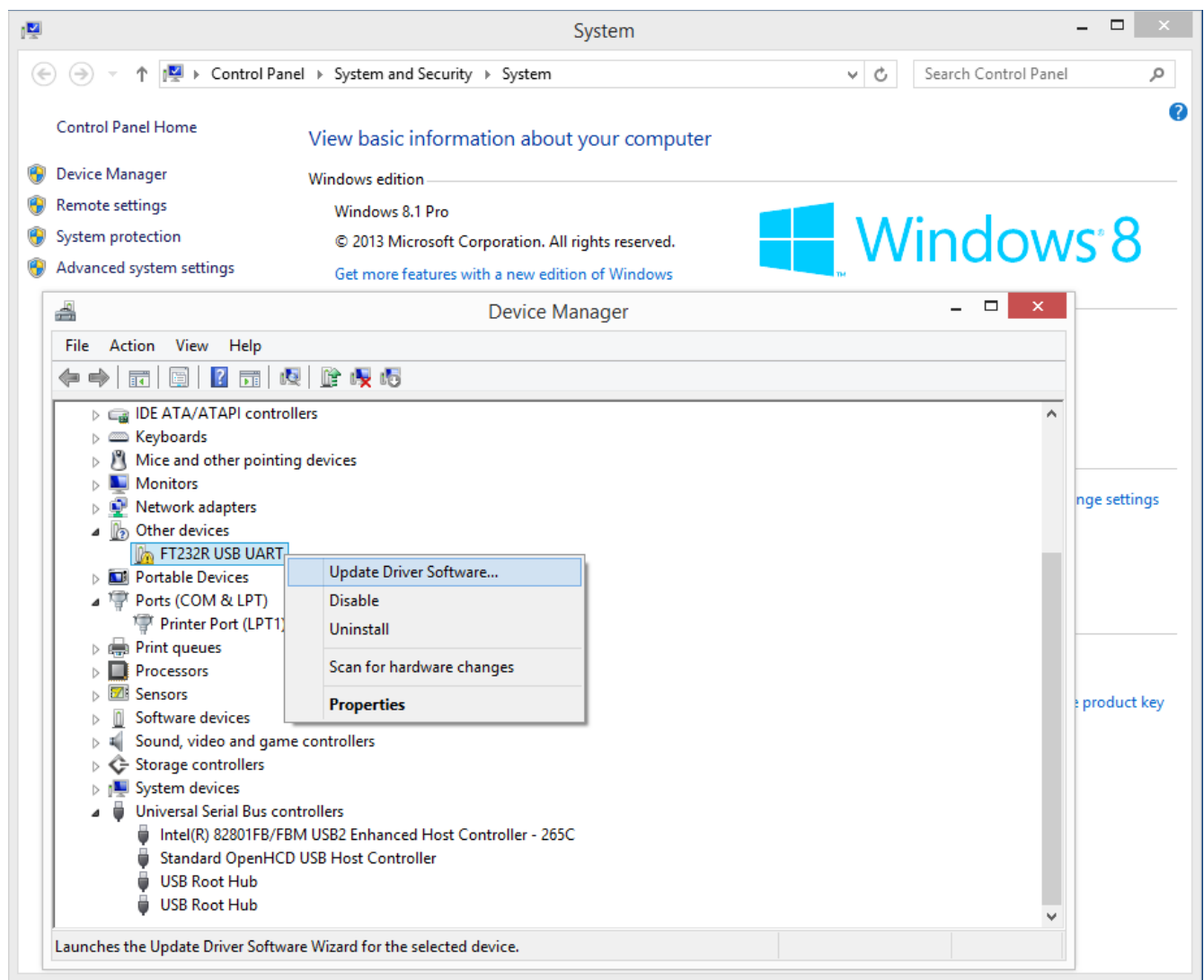
Manual Windows 8.0 and 8.1 Driver Installation for FTDI USB Interfaces with PID = 0 Problem

This signed driver package for Windows 8 is for FTDI USB interfaces with the PID = 0 problem. It will also work with normal Interfaces and Windows 7. Navigate to the device manager and search for FT232 devices with yellow exclamation mark.

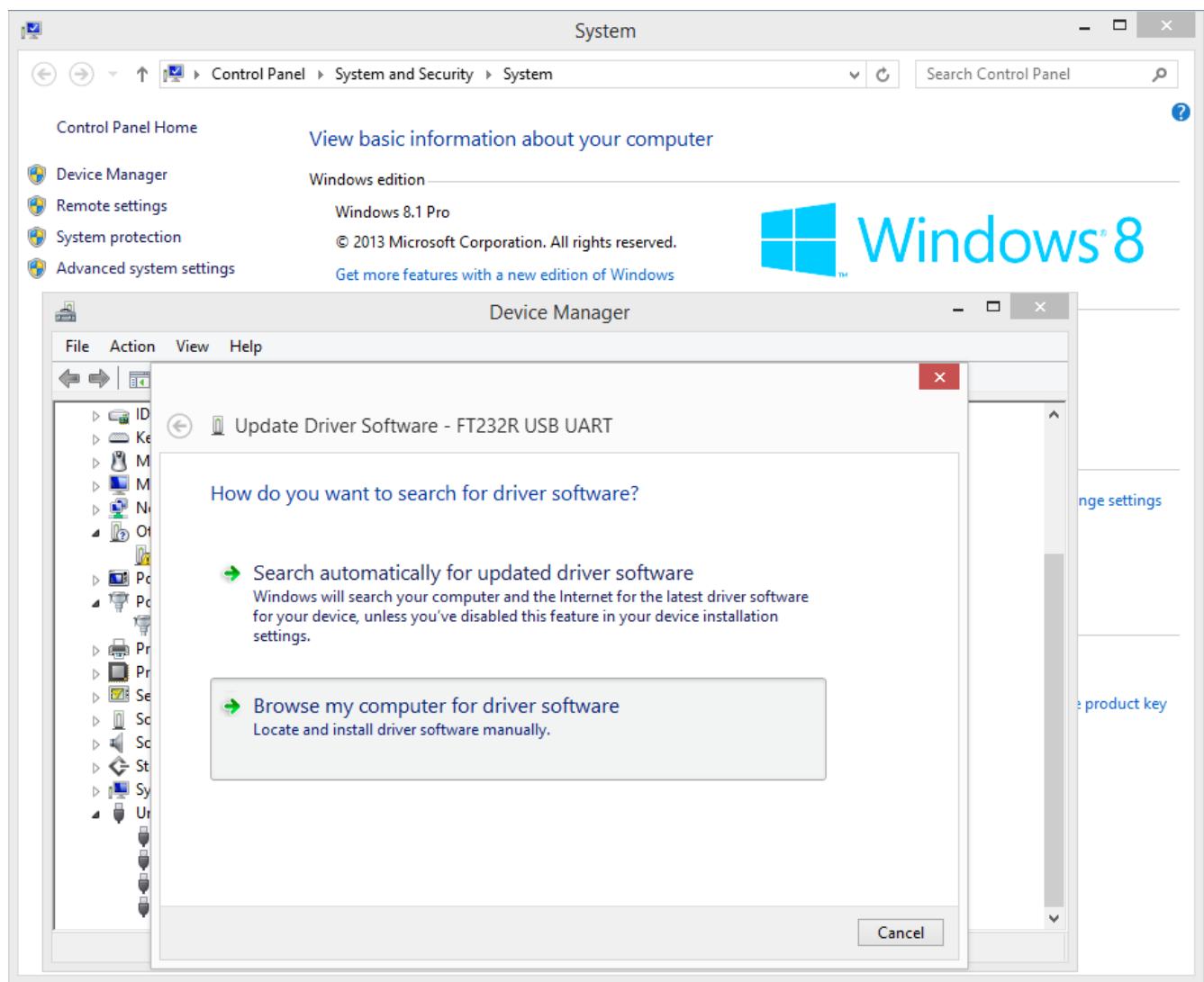


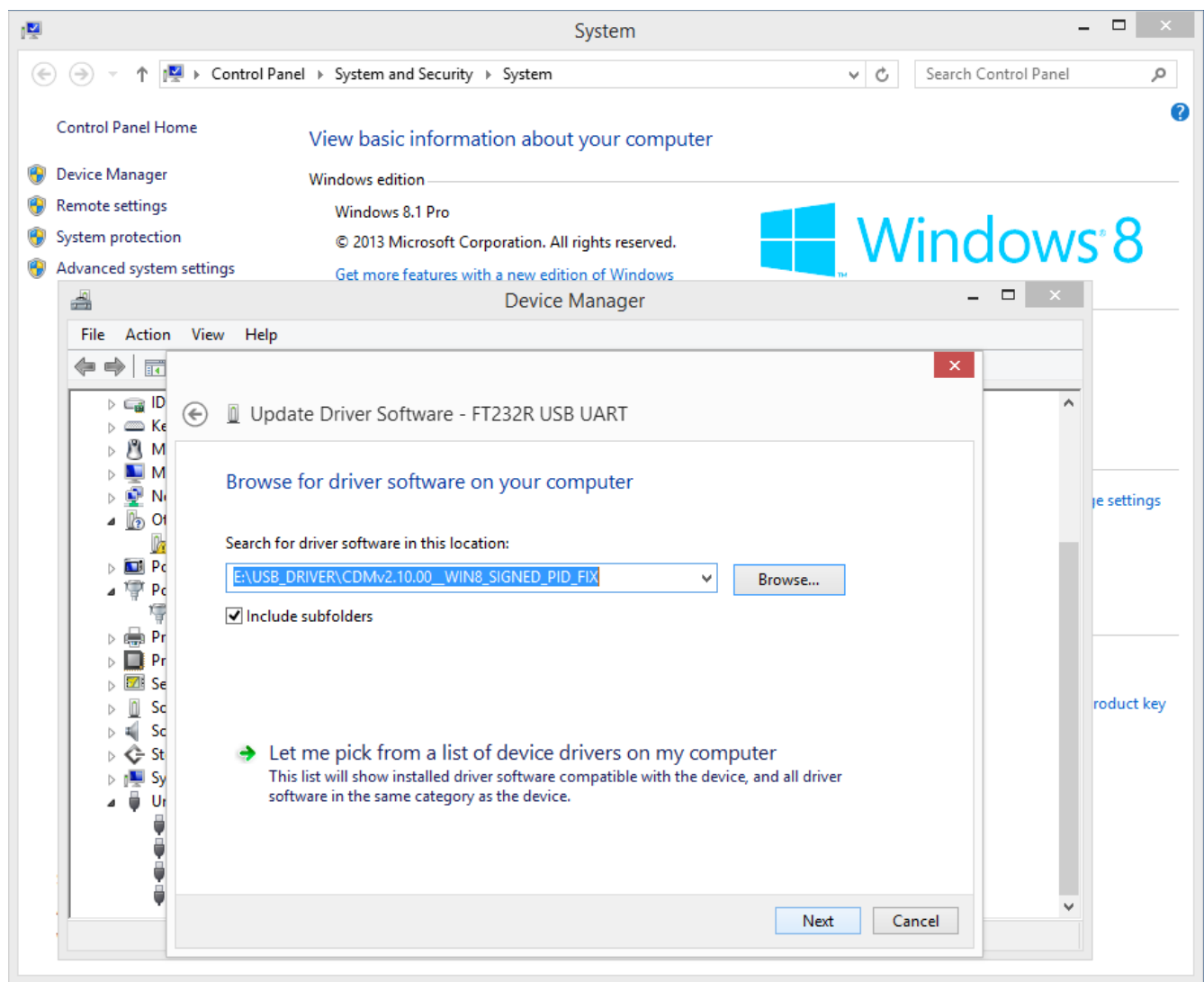
You can check if the interface really has the PID = 0 problem in the properties, check „Hardware Ids“ and look for PID_0000:

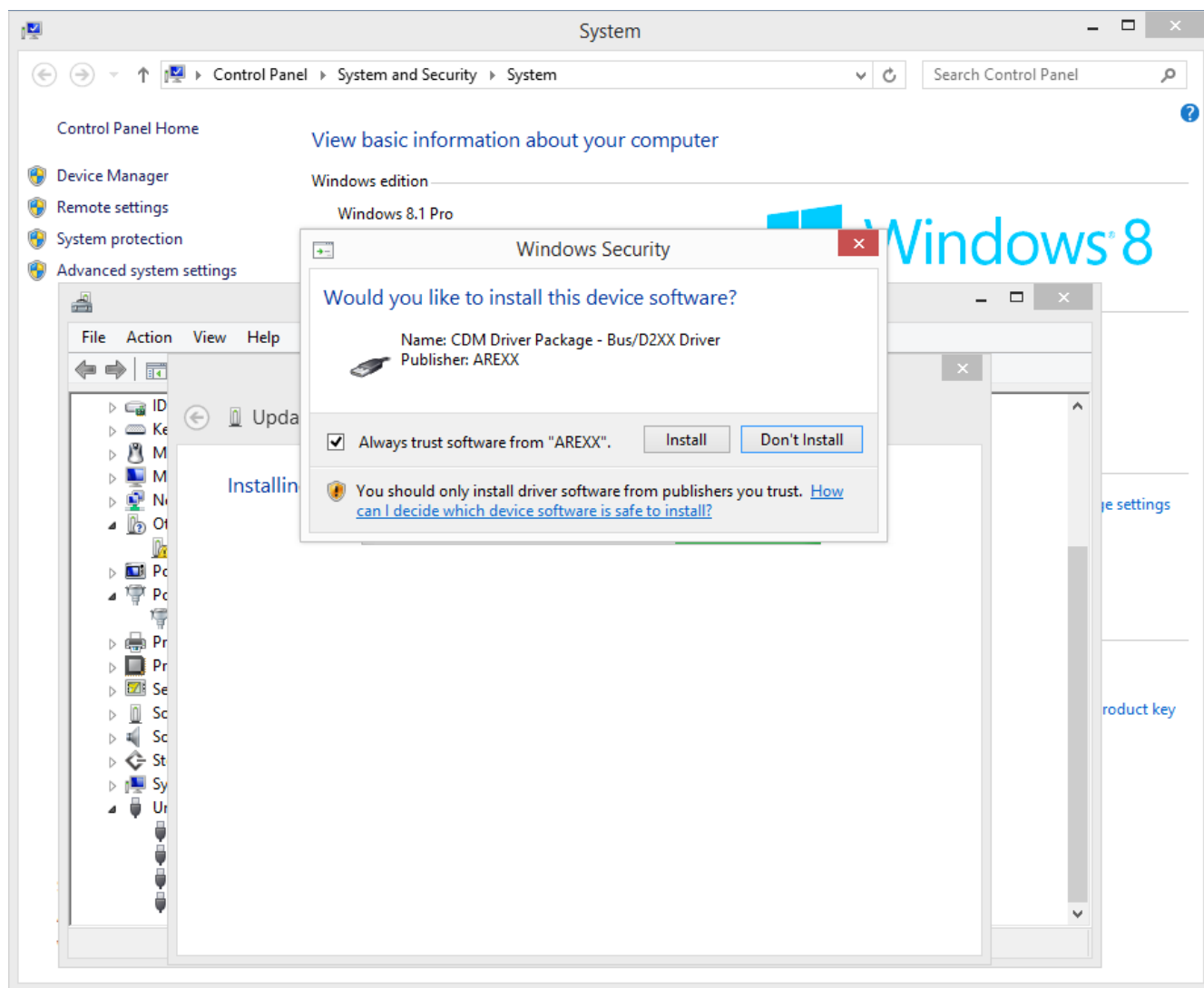


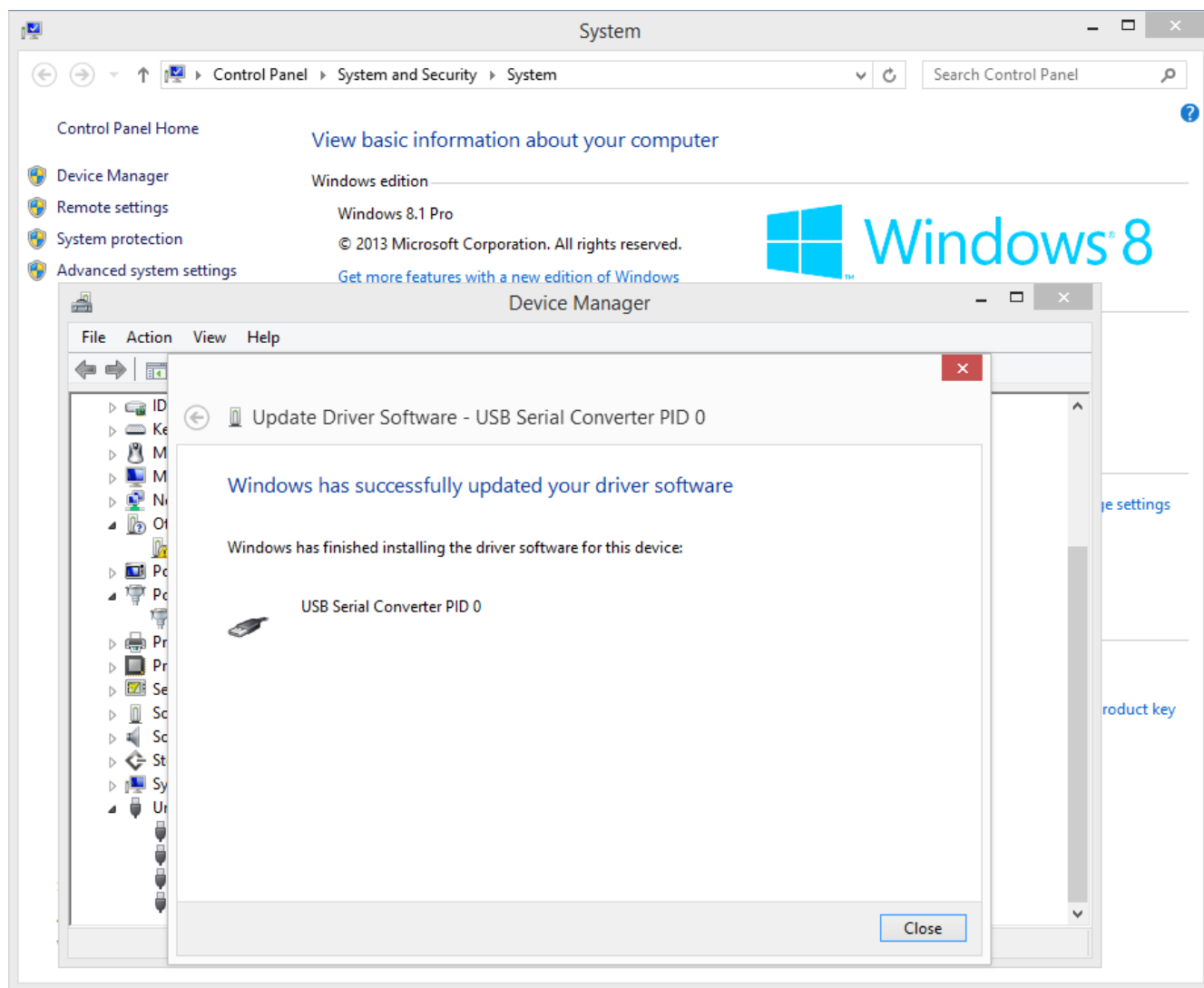


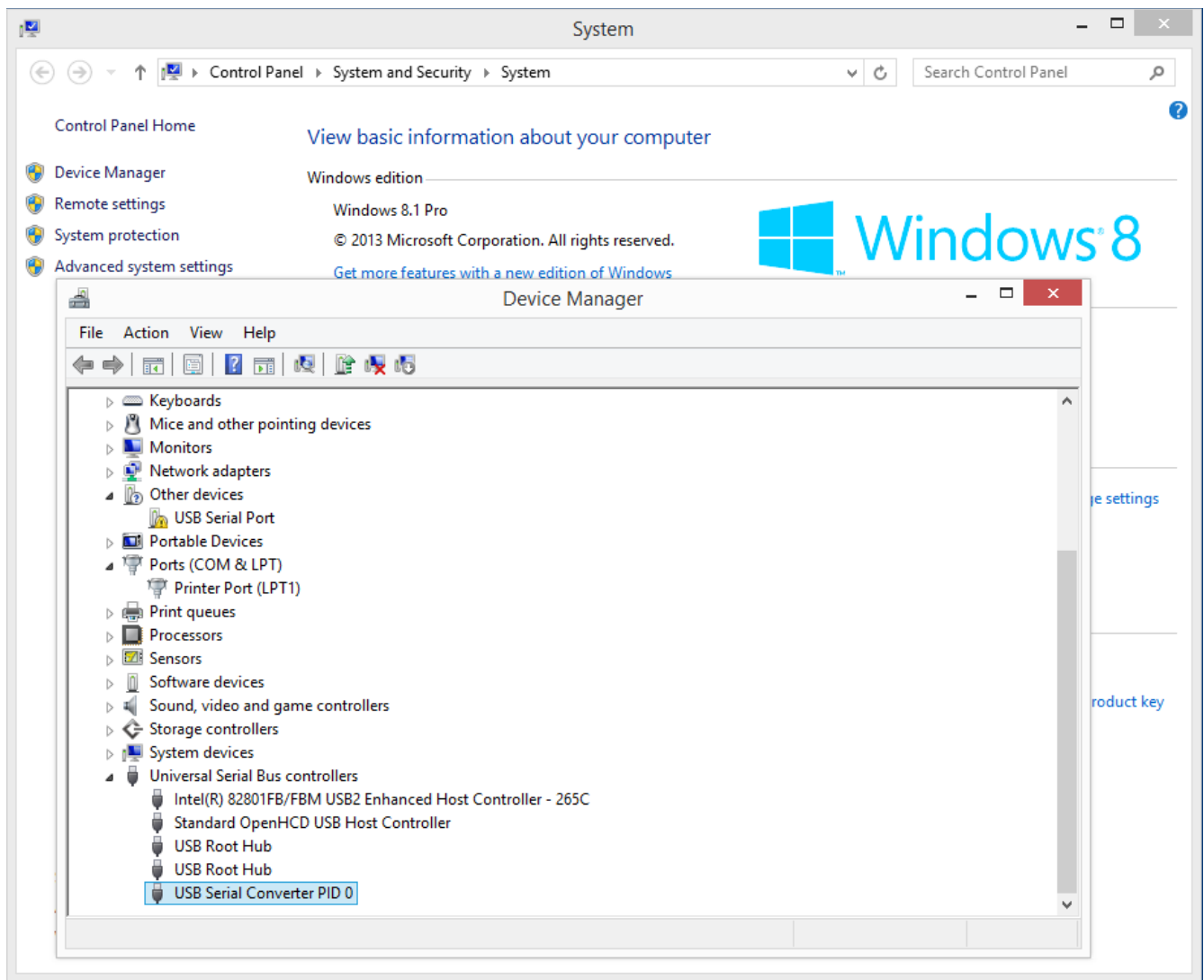
Please note that you have to install the Driver from TWO device entries separately. The other one may appear after you installed it for the first device entry!

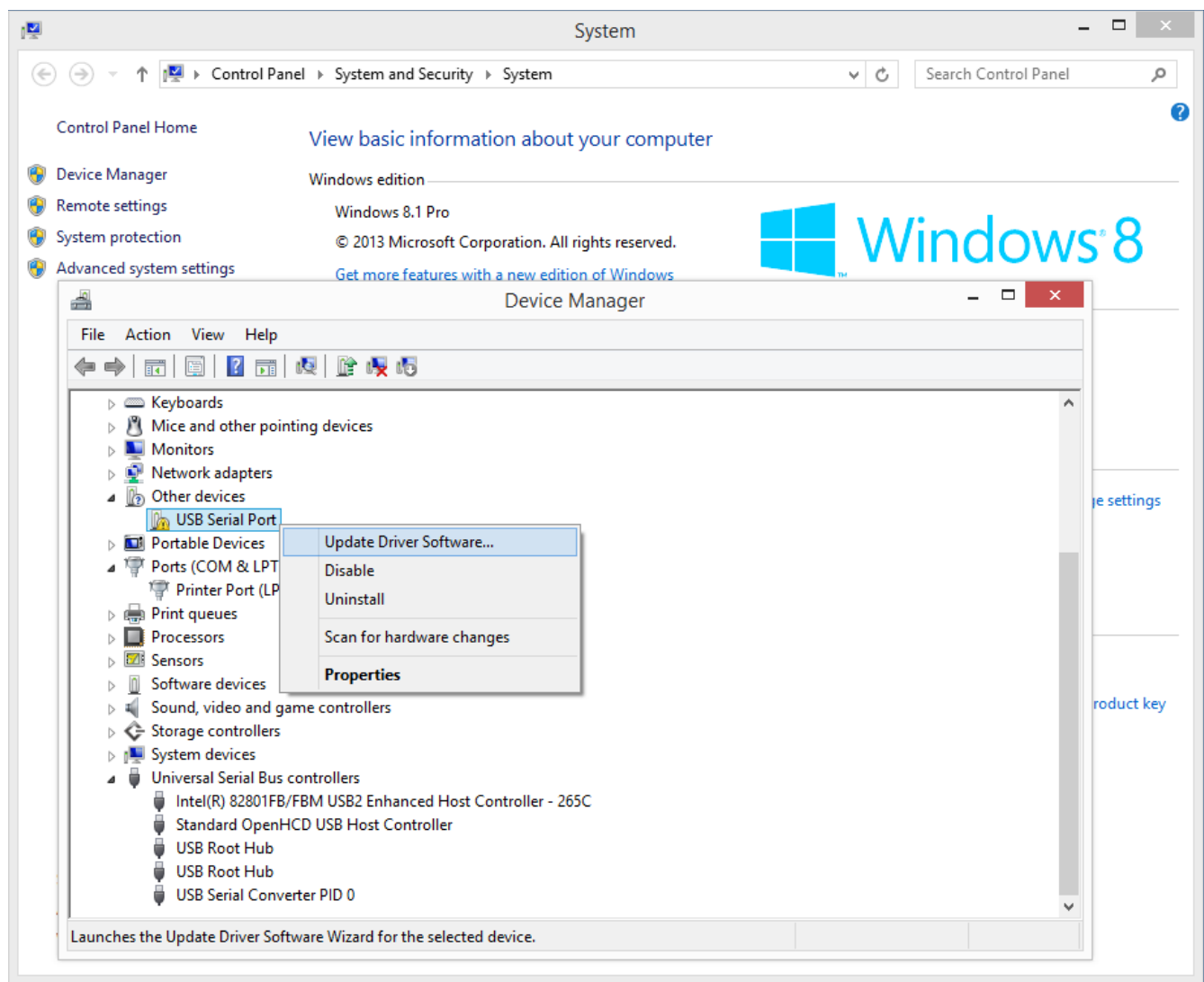




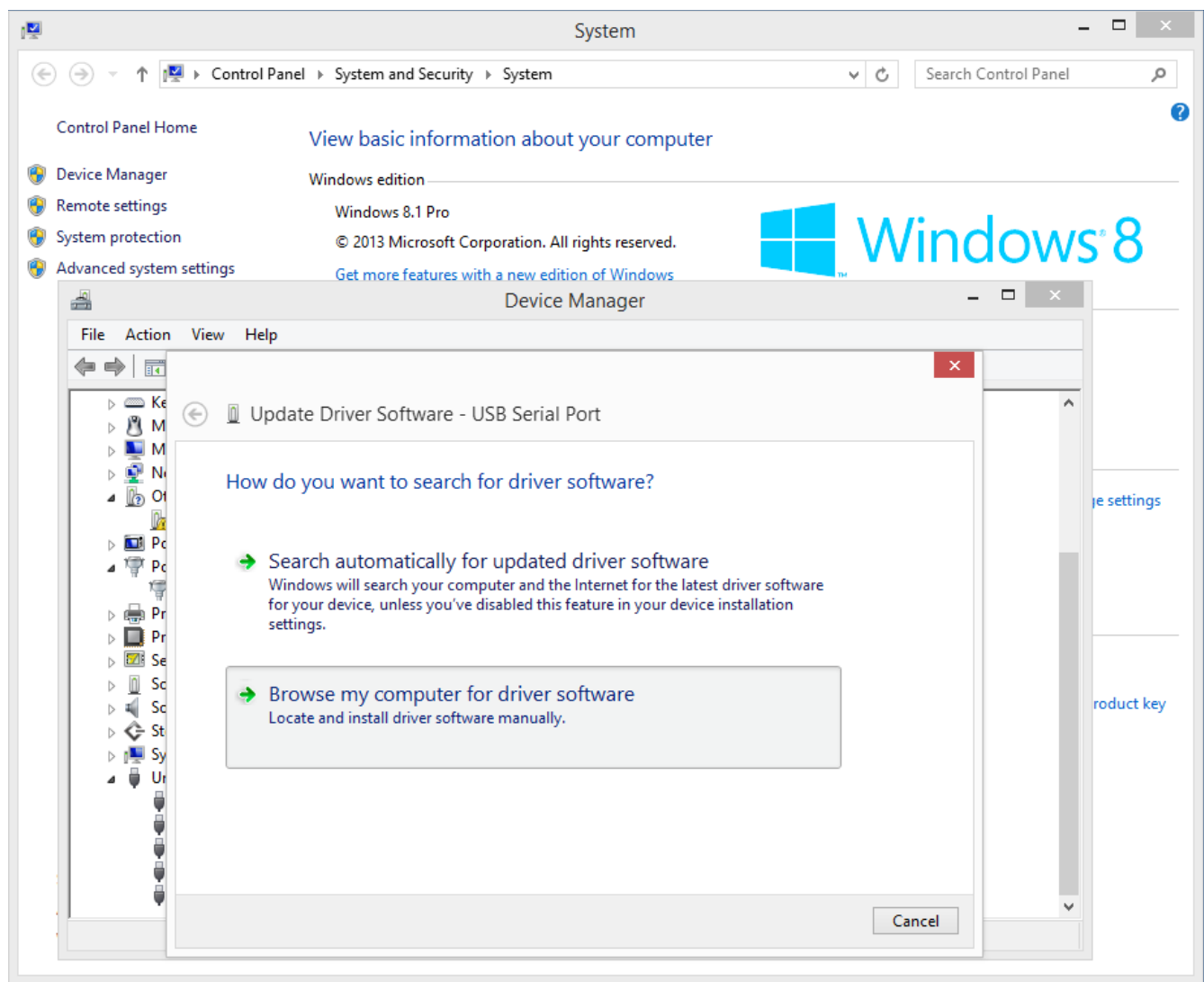


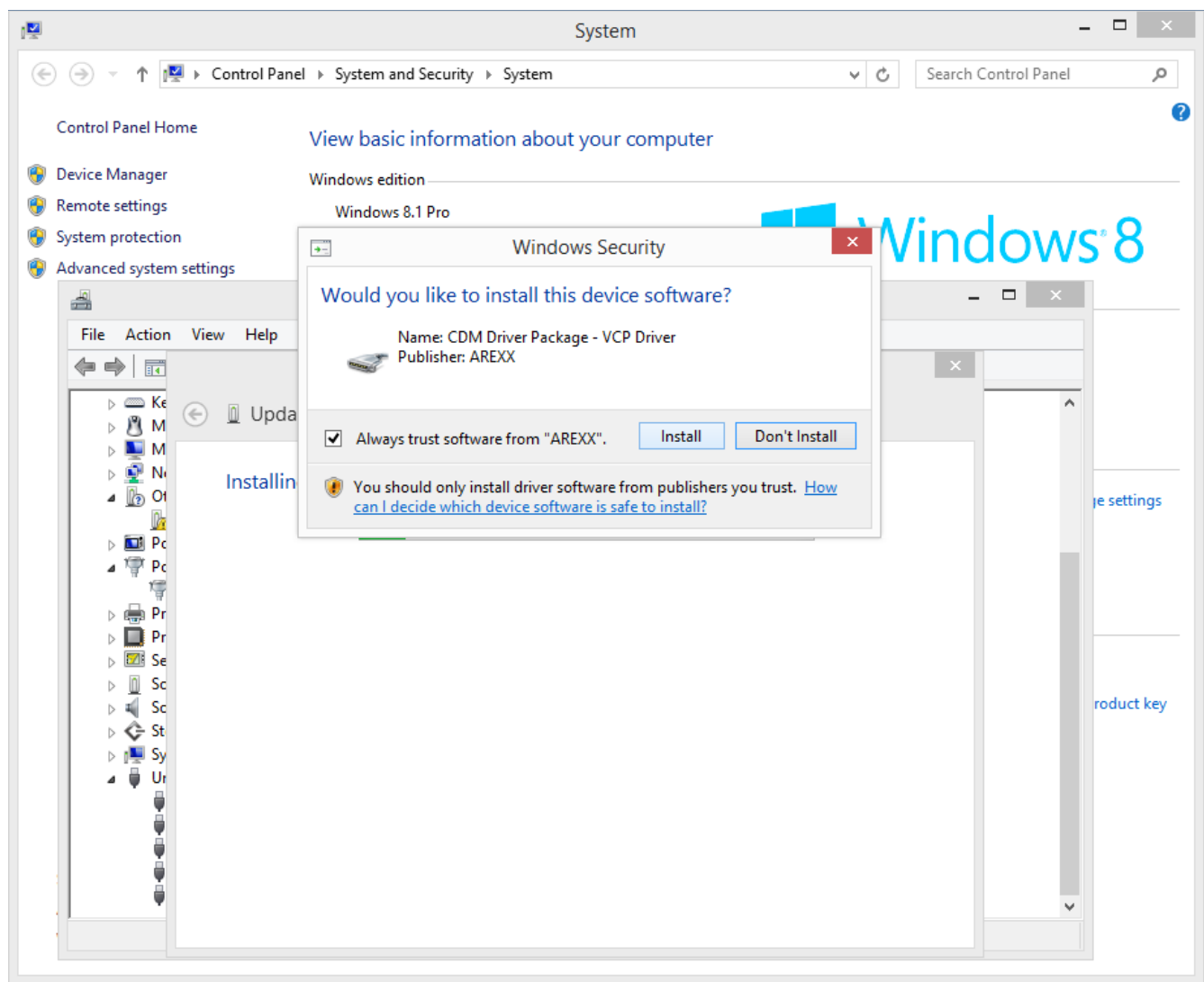


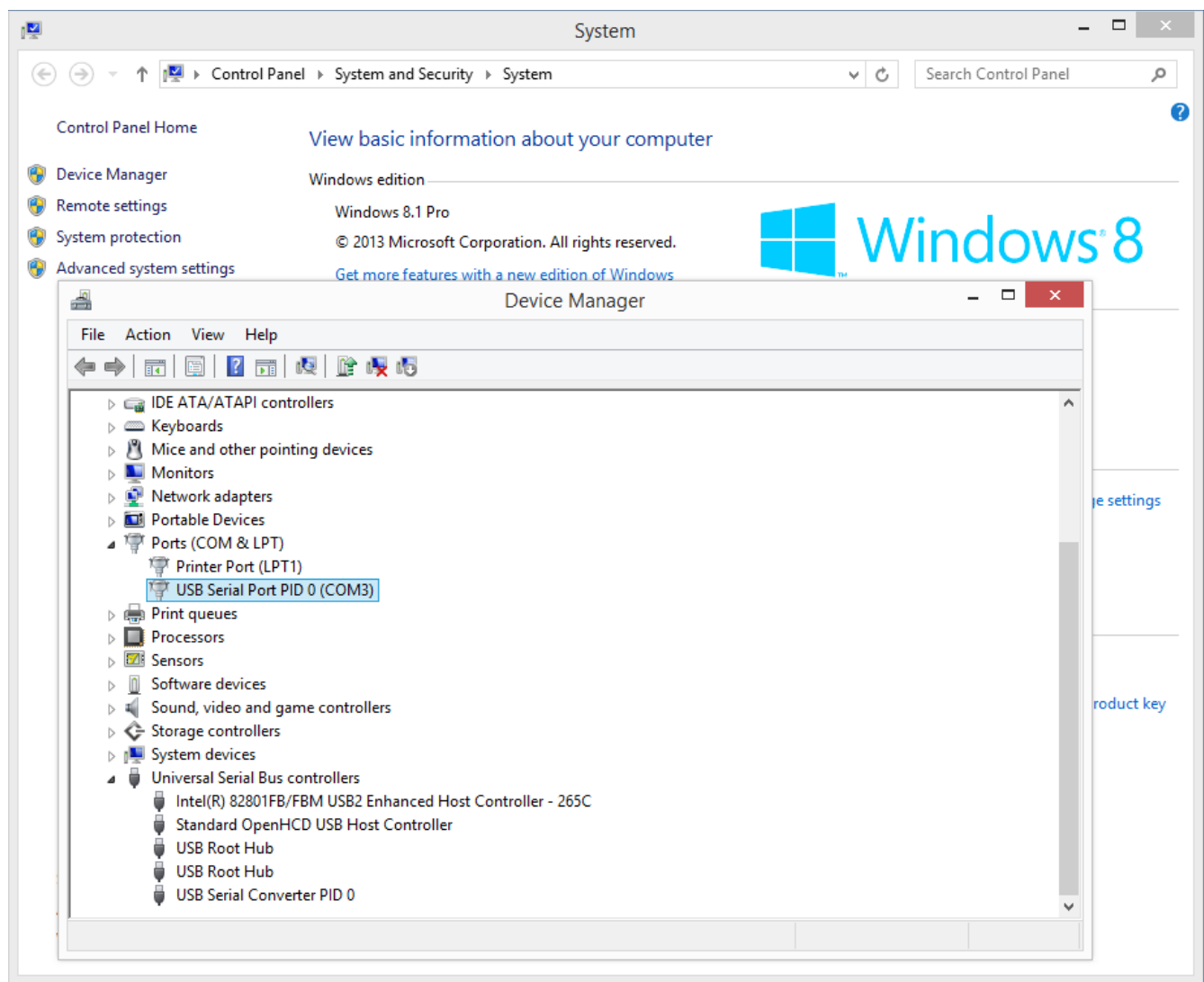




This is the second device entry, steps are the same.
